COURSE DESCRIPTION

5-day

The terminal objective of this course is that the student will be able to identify the target lock(s), the doors or hardware that they are on and determine the best method of defeat; enter the facility, take control of the asset and exit the facility without leaving evidence of the entry.

Locks & Locking Devices used in Level One.

This course will:

- Teach students to be able to identify a wide variety of foreign and domestic locks
- Provide students with a working knowledge of various mechanical and electro-mechanical locks and associated components
- Cover surreptitious, covert, and forced entry techniques for each lock type through lecture and hands-on practical exercises
- Discuss, demonstrate, and develop working skill with a variety of state-of-the-art and proven covert, surreptitious bypass equipment
- Plan and conduct a series of entry exercises against several layers of security barriers

Each student is given an extensive tool kit to use in class and to take home with them after the course.

Due to the nature of certain LSI courses some applicants may not be permitted enrollment.

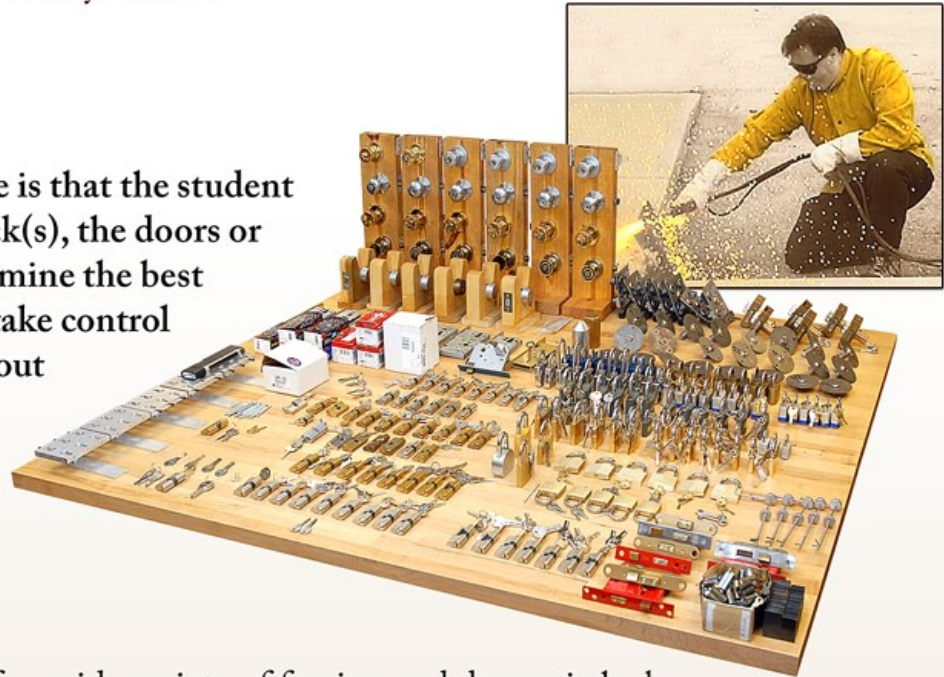
